Qualifications for Applicants

- Must live within Reno County
- Must meet Federal Income Guidelines

- For Early Head Start services must be pregnant or have a child birth to 24 months

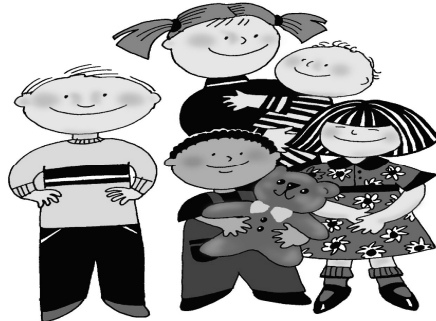

To complete the application you **must** bring birth verification (birth certificate, hospital certificate, or medical card) and proof of income for the last calendar year or the previous 12 months (tax statement, paycheck stubs, and documentation of child support, alimony, unemployment, cash assistance, SSI, etc.).
